OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this scholarship are to inspire hope for a brighter tomorrow and build confidence in the power of dreams. We hope this scholarship will ignite a desire in recipients to search for their life purpose and find meaning in each day. Our vision is that recipients will commit to "pay it forward" and continue a cascade of goodwill and concern for others.

ELIGIBILITY

Recipients must:

- Be an active member of 13thirty Cancer Connect whose actions have mirrored the award objectives.
- Be enrolled in an accredited, undergraduate college degree program.
- Demonstrate the personal qualities necessary to meet the award objectives.
- Commit to helping 13thirty Cancer Connect continue its mission of helping teens and young adults with cancer live their very best lives.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications will be accepted from graduating high school seniors, enrolled college undergraduates, and non-traditional students entering college for the first time. Past recipients may re-apply but priority will be given to first time applicants.

Application is a two-part process:

- 1) The written application including two essay questions is due June 7, 2019 (Sections A-E)
- 2) Selected candidates will be invited to meet with the Selection Committee at a mutually convenient time, June 7 - July 12, 2019.

SELECTION PROCESS;

The Selection Committee including representatives from the Associate Board and Jeffrey Carlton, the award donor, will review all applications and select the recipient. Recipients will be notified by August 16 pending verification of college registration. 13thirty staff will be excluded from the selection process to ensure independent review.

The successful candidate will be awarded a \$2,000 scholarship which will be sent directly to the college where the recipient is registered and applied to his/her student account.
